Packaging

The glove is packaged one pair per poly wallet, sealed in a poly envelope; 10 pairs per sealed polybag; 5 sealed polybags per master polybag; 4 master polybags per lined carton; 200 pairs per carton. All packaging is printed with cleanroom-compatible IPA-resistant ink. The gloves are triple-bagged for superior contamination control. The polybags have an easy-tear opening.

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
