

Disporoll is essential for cleaning areas at risk of cross-contamination (operating theatres, fire and rescue services, etc.) or simply if you don't want to use a laundry.








1 Remove the precut washcloth



2 Dampen the microfiber washcloth



3 Fold in two



4 Use flat on the surface, using a different face every time you move to a new surface



Always start with the cleanest areas and finish with the most soiled areas.
